

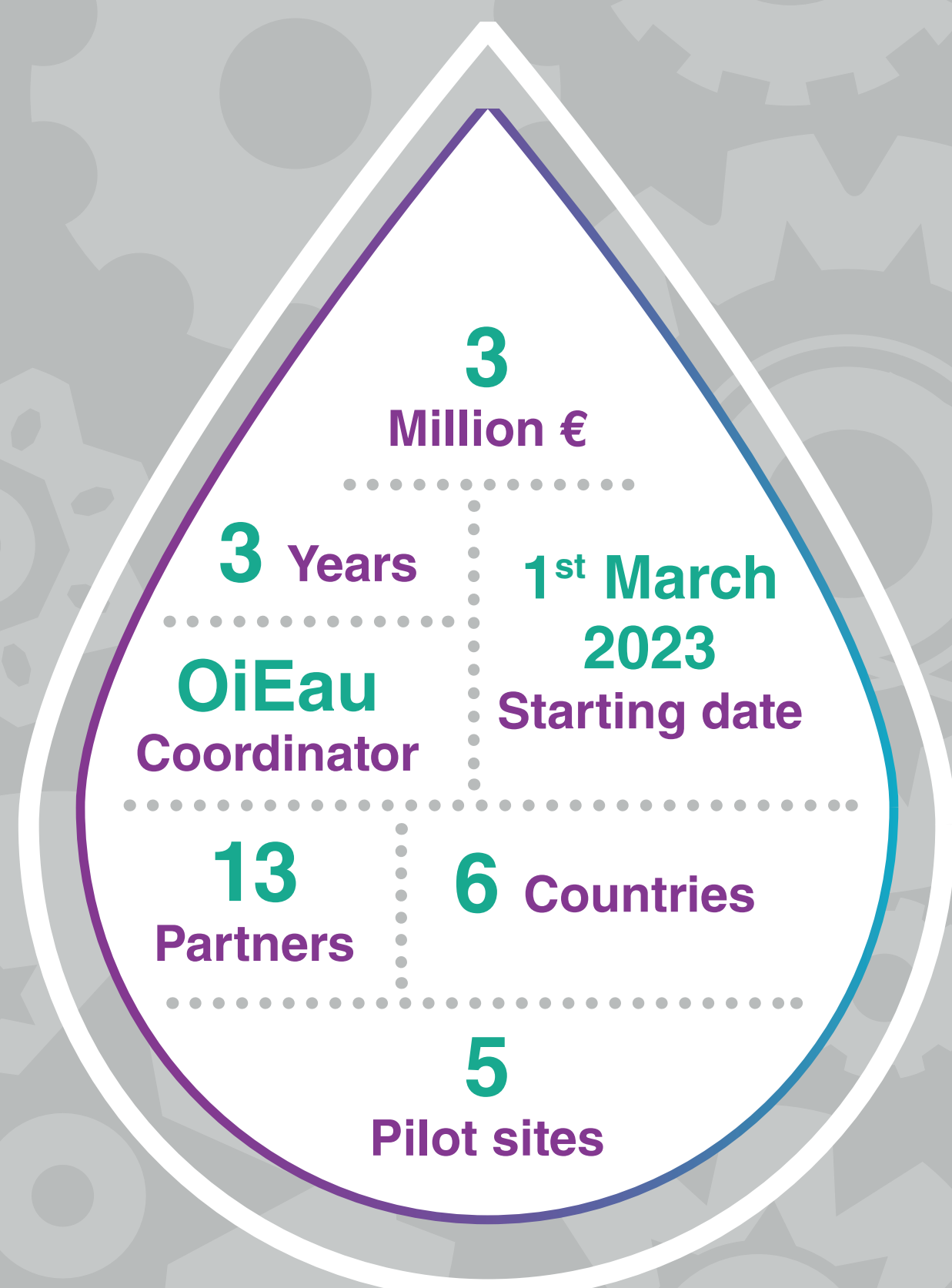

5 Pilot sites, implementing different types of governance mechanisms and covering different **water challenges**, **test** and **co-develop** the tools and methods.

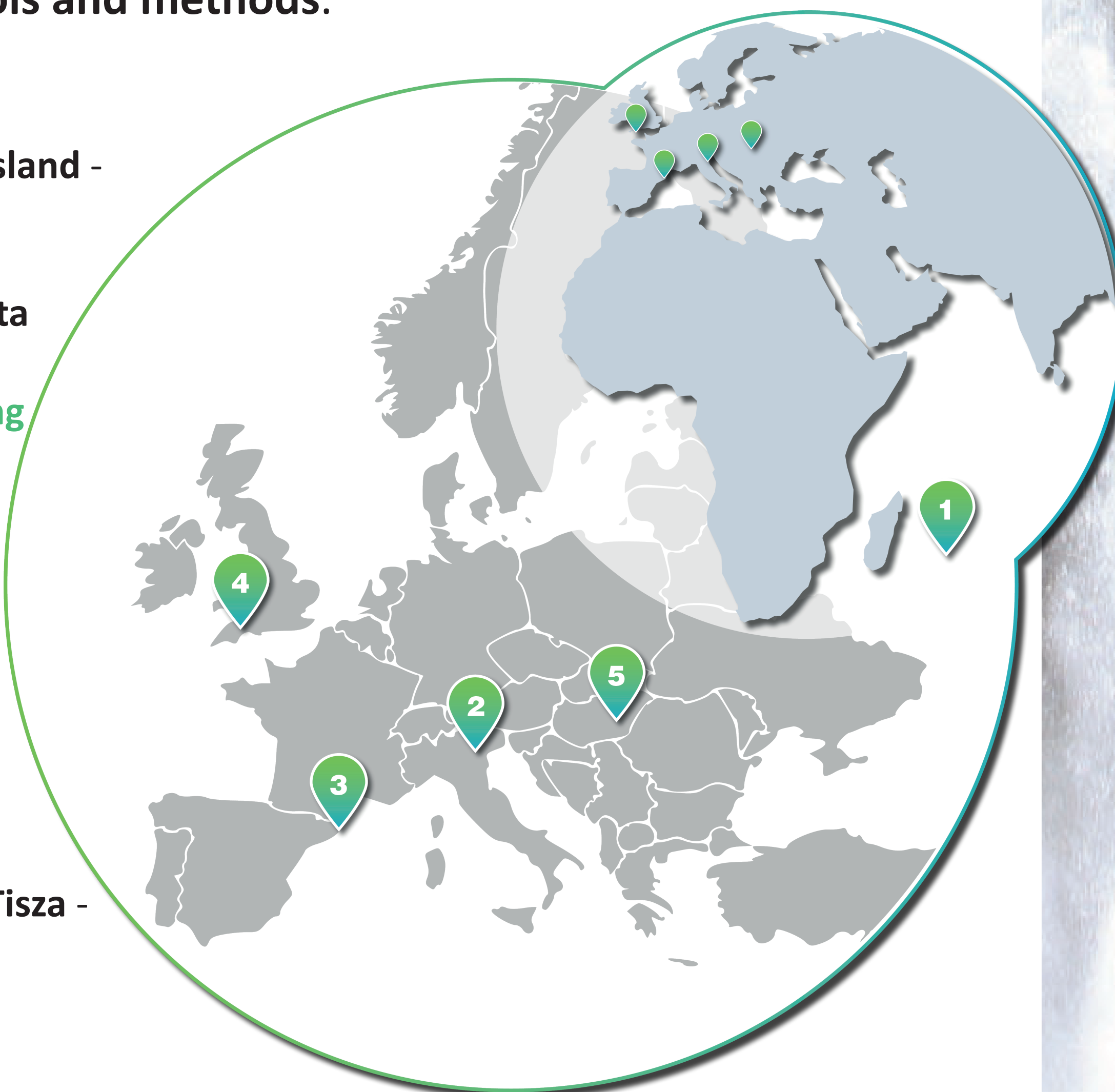
1 France, Reunion Island - **Economic focus**
